



W. Tip Hall, Jr. Scholarship Operating Guidelines

The CoServ Electric scholarship is named after W. Tip Hall, Jr., a longtime educator, preacher and legislator who served on the CoServ Electric Board of Directors for ten years. Mr. Hall's love and commitment to education and his work in developing the Scholarship program for CoServ Electric, is the reason the scholarship bears his name. The purpose of this program is to encourage and support the academic endeavors of graduating high school seniors with an established connection to the electric cooperative, as they seek their education in an institute of higher learning in the state of Texas.

Number of Scholarships

The number of scholarships available to be awarded will be determined each year based on the availability of funds and the eligibility of applicants.

Eligibility of Applicants

Applicants for the scholarship must meet the following requirements:

1. A **high school senior** who is a US citizen and;
2. The student's **permanent** residence is served by CoServ Electric and;
3. Have a **minimum of one-year membership** with CoServ Electric and **be in good standing**;
4. All requested documents must be received by CoServ Electric no later than close of business (5 p.m.) on Jan. 31, 2012 and/or postmarked no later than Jan. 31, 2012.

Eligibility of Recipients

Scholarship recipients must be enrolled full time in an accredited institution of higher learning located in the state of Texas (college, university, trade or vocational school). Enrolled full time is as defined by the registrar of the institution.

Amount of Scholarship

Each 2012 scholarship awarded is for the amount of \$2,500.00.

Payment of Scholarship

It is the responsibility of the scholarship recipient to send CoServ the documentation confirming their enrollment and acknowledging full-time status. Within ten business days following the receipt of the requested documents, CoServ will issue the scholarship payment. Funds will be forwarded directly to the institution in which the student is enrolled. The scholarship offer will become void if it is not claimed by Feb. 1, 2013.
