



## Application for Reimbursement



CoServ Electric's Think Green Rebate Program (effective Jan. 1, 2012) is an incentive program that offers rebates to residential Members who make qualified energy efficiency improvements to their homes. The program is a great way for residential Members to use energy more efficiently and save money.

### Rebate Offers

#### Heat Pump Rebate

Members who replace existing HVAC equipment (in electric-only, single family homes) are eligible to receive a \$150 rebate for a 14 SEER (with an HSPF of 8.2) High Efficiency Heat Pump and a \$300 rebate for a 15 SEER (with an HSPF of 9.0) High Efficiency Heat Pump (or higher). The incentive rebates for this program apply for replacement of existing HVAC equipment at any residential home and new home construction. The Member must provide a copy of the receipt and a copy of the Air-Conditioning Heating and Refrigeration Institute ("AHRI") certificate from the installing contractor for verification purposes. This incentive rebate is not applicable for homes that use natural gas for heating.

#### Compact Fluorescent Lighting Program

Residential Members who have an energy audit performed on their homes are eligible to receive up to \$50 worth of compact fluorescent lamps (CFLs) for their most frequently used fixtures. ### HVAC Tune-Up

Residential Members who have an energy audit performed on their single family homes are eligible to receive up to a \$150 rebate on an HVAC tune-up performed by a qualified service professional. An annual HVAC tune up includes: checking and correcting the unit's refrigerant pressure and tubing, checking and adjusting belt tension, cleaning and lubricating the indoor blower unit, replacing filters, cleaning inside the "A" coil, and checking the thermostat, wiring, and other electric parts. A copy of the receipt from a qualified contractor stating that the work above was completed must be provided for verification purposes. ### ENERGY STAR® Home Rebate

Members who build ENERGY STAR rated homes (that closed after January 1, 2012) are eligible to receive a \$550 rebate. A copy of the ENERGY STAR certificate is required to be eligible for this program.

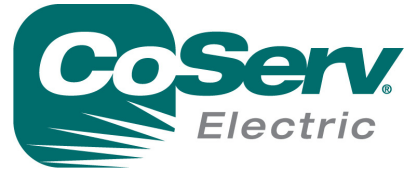
### High Efficiency Water Heater

Members who replace their electric water heater with a high efficiency (.94 EF or higher) electric water heater are eligible to receive a \$25 rebate. Members must provide a copy of the receipt along with a copy of the Energy Guide label for verification purposes.

## ENERGY STAR® Window AC Unit

Members who purchase and install an ENERGY STAR qualified (10.8 EER or higher) window unit are eligible to receive a \$30 rebate. Members must provide a copy of the receipt along with a copy of the Energy Guide label for verification purposes.

## ENERGY STAR® Dishwasher

Members who replace their existing dishwasher with an EnergyStar qualified (.65 EF or higher) dishwasher are eligible to receive a \$15 rebate. Members must provide a copy of the receipt along with a copy of the Energy Guide label for verification purposes.

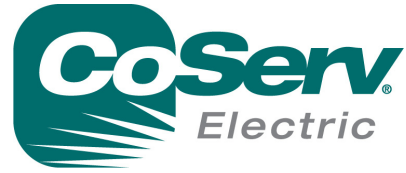

## ~~Solar Energy Rebate~~ Funding for the Solar Energy Rebate was depleted on January 17, 2012.

~~CoServ supports interconnected co-generation with net metering—per the terms of our tariff. CoServ offers a \$2 per DC watt rebate on solar generation (with a \$5,000 cap per Member installation) until allocated funds are depleted. Members must follow the guidelines set by CoServ’s tariff and Distributed Generation Procedures and Guidelines Manual for Members.
